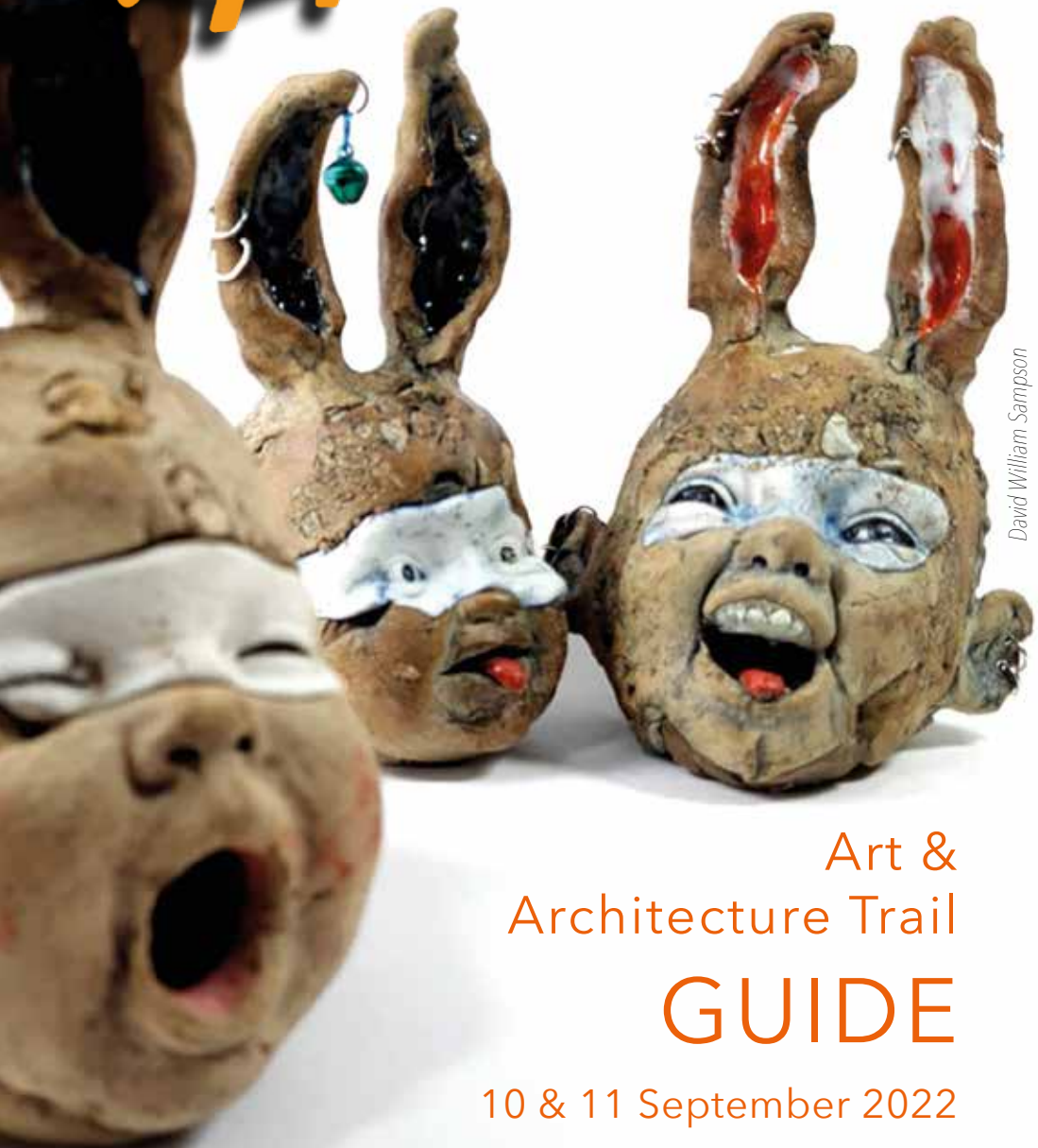




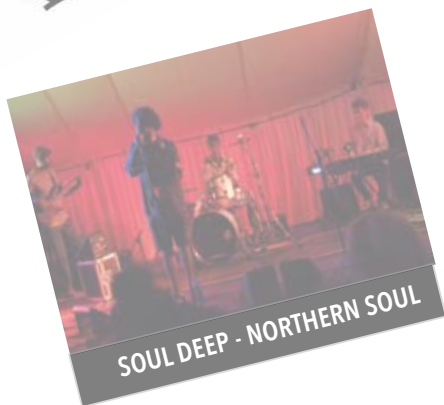

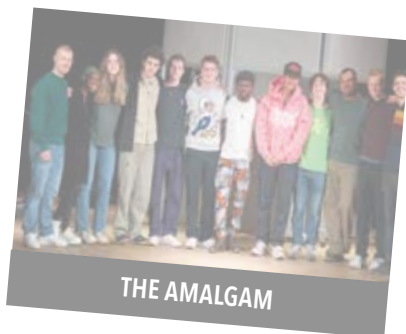

FESTIVAL ARTIST IN RESIDENCE 21-22



Liane Lang is a London-based artist who studied at the National College of Art and Design in Dublin and completed a BA in Fine Art at Goldsmiths College, London followed by an MA at the Royal Academy Schools. She has exhibited widely both in the UK and internationally, including the Musée de Beaux Arts Calais, PS1 New York and Kunstverein Heidelberg. She won the Photofusion

Award, the Tooth Travel Award at Goldsmiths College and the Cheneviere Prize at the Royal Academy Schools. she graduated in 2006.

Her work is held in numerous prestigious collections, such as Arts Council England, the Royal Academy of Arts, the Saatchi Collection, Deutsche Bank, Kunstverein Bregenz, Ernst and Young and the Collection of the Kunstamt Spandau, Berlin. During 2019 she was based in Bilbao for a residency at BilbaoArte Fundacion.

Liane joined us in the summer of 2021 as the Wirksworth Festival's second artist-in-residence. A visual artist, she has a special interest in statues and historic monuments. Her practice is primarily photographic,





often using alternative processes and printing on a variety of materials including stone, concrete and metals.

She spent her time in Wirksworth looking at the idea of landscape as memorial. She was particularly interested in exploring the region for objects and features that retain and retell histories, both natural and man-made and to talk to people about their experience of the landscape. She completes her residency with two exhibitions at the Maltings and the Moot Hall.

The Festival's artist in residence programme, also known as, the Lodge Project is funded by the Ampersand Trust and aims to give an established, UK-based artist 3-months of dedicated and funded studio time in Wirksworth to develop new directions in their work with an emphasis on life in and around the locality of the Festival.

This exhibition includes work made during and after Liane's residency at the Wirksworth Festival. The project includes sculpture, photography, drawing and print, using found objects and materials like lead, stone and relics of industrial and farming machinery.

....Derbyshire feels like a museum to human history. Tightly packed are traces and tracks of our activities going back thousands of years. Mounds and mines, quarries and caves, fields and rock faces. And in the bucolic beauty rumble away vast machines extracting aggregate, milling sand, huge lorries roar down picturesque lanes, moving tons of rock....



Included in the exhibition is Aggregate, a video collaboration with sound artist Phillip Benjamin Schlotter, commissioned by the Chur Festival of Jazz Switzerland and shot almost entirely in Derbyshire.

Also on display will be the film Touch Stone, by Tom Dwyer. Commissioned by Wirksworth Festival, the film documents Liane's time in the area

FESTIVAL ARTIST IN RESIDENCE 22-23



Jemma Gunning, a print maker based in Bristol is the Festival's third Artist in Residence. She will be presenting a major exhibition at the 2023 Festival but this year she is exhibiting initial drawings at Venue 1, St Mary's Church. She explains her work below:

My practice explores the documentation of urban and industrial decline. My fascination with recording the passage of time is evoked with nostalgia and the questions that arise around the lost and forgotten landscapes.

Urban exploration and documenting architectural decline re-connects the present day to the past. I increasingly feel this is important and a way of recording our heritage before it vanishes from our society.

Drawing underpins my practice and informs my printmaking processes. Specialising in etching and lithography, these methods resonate with the subjects I come to find myself documenting. They use an enforced decay, whereby acids erode metal and physically alter the surface of a limestone, echoing with the natural decay of the architectural forms I draw.





Since being Artist in Residence and walking many miles, I have taken an interest in geology, mapping, and mining practices. I have spent time drawing quarries, trying to understand the rock formations but more importantly recording the scarring of the landscape which is evident around every corner. Each quarry, mine, and mill represents a different world, a different time zone, some far longer than humans have been on the planet.

The work being shown at St Mary's for this year's festival are a selection of charcoal and ink drawings,

documenting the human altered landscapes and derelict post-industrial spaces.

I am looking forward to getting back to my studio in Bristol to transfer the large drawings I've made whilst in Wirksworth into prints to show at next year's festival.
